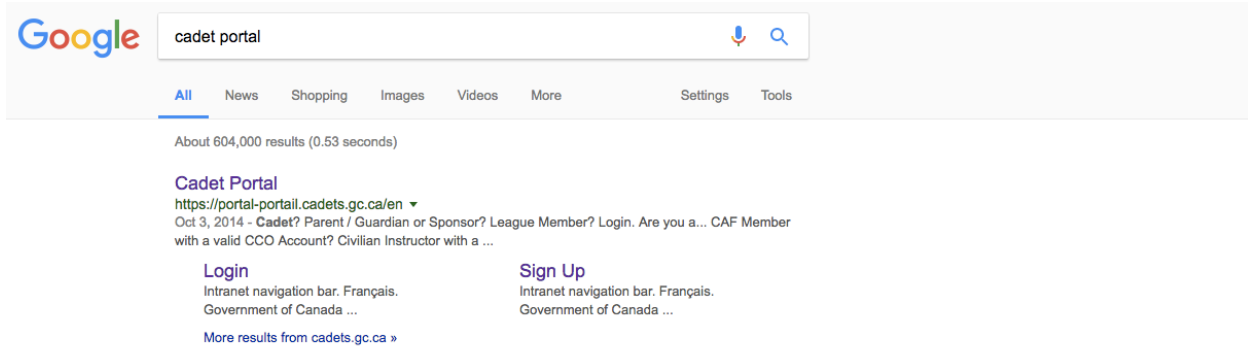
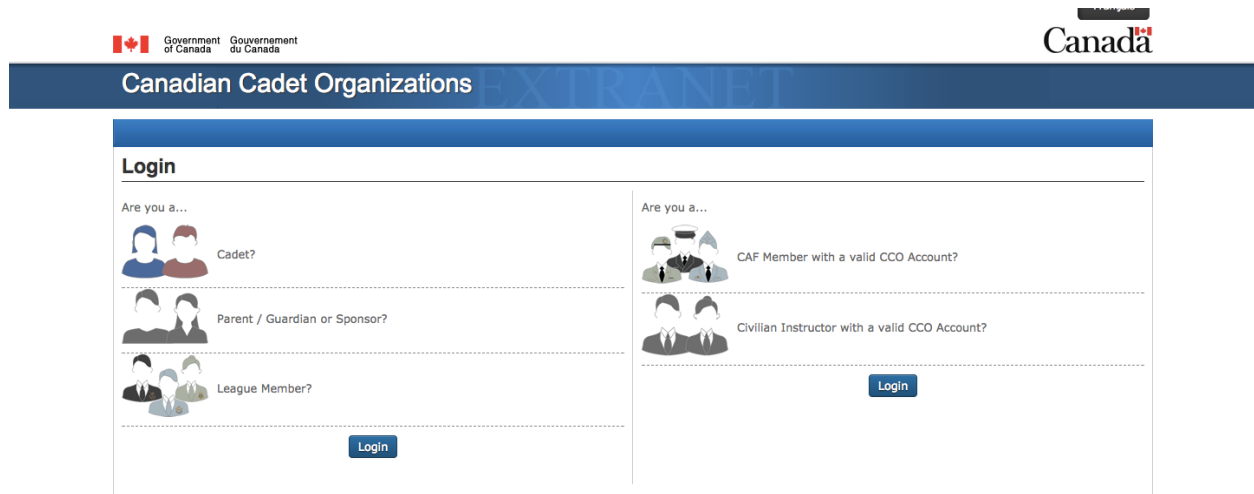


How to access the Cadet Portal to retrieve IG's/QSP's and CATO's/ SpGp Orders

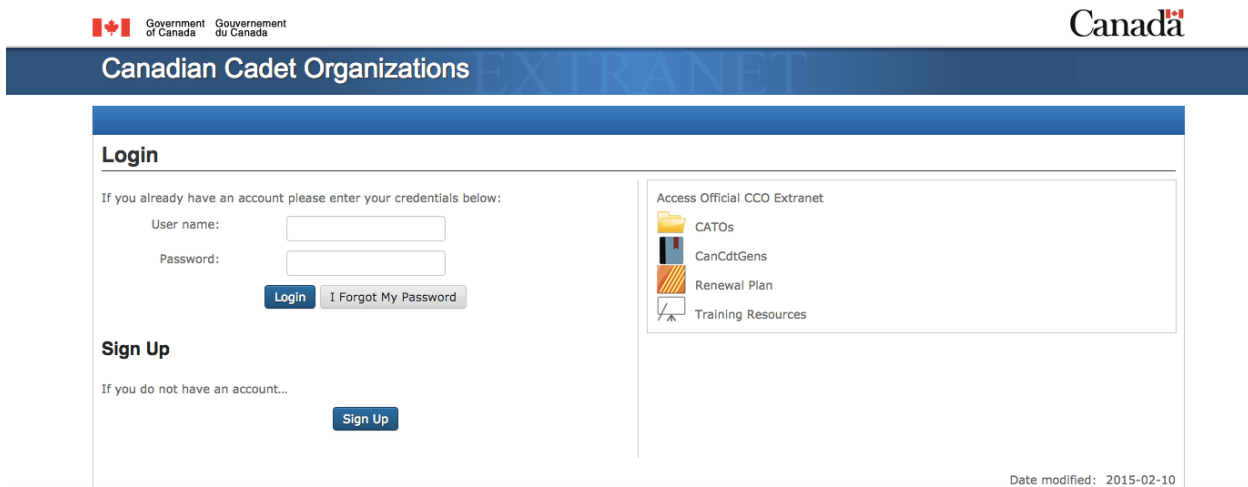
Step 1: Search for "cadet portal" in your web browser

Natl CJCR Sp Gp Orders

Natl CJCR Sp Gp Orders provide guidance with respect to Natl CJCR Sp Gp policy and procedures on a wide range of matters relevant to the Natl CJCR Sp Gp operations and administration. They are issued to supplement and amplify existing orders and regulations, and provide direction on matters specific to the Natl CJCR Sp Gp.

Cadet Administrative and Training Orders (CATOs)

CATOs are issued by Natl CJCR Sp Gp to supplement Queen's Regulations and Orders for Cadets (QR(Cadets)), amplify Canadian Forces Administrative Orders (CFAOs), replace Canadian Forces Cadet Policies and Procedures (CFCPP), and to minimize the requirement for specialized Region Orders and Instructions.

Be advised that the CATOs are in the process of being superseded by Natl CJCR Sp Gp Orders, manuals, standard operating procedures (SOPs) or other instruments, or are being cancelled completely with no replacement instrument, as required. As such, CATOs are neither being written nor amended.

CANCDTGENs

CANCDTGENs provide information about programs, policies, and events that affect all members of the CCO.

Queen's Regulations and Orders for the Canadian Cadet Organizations (QR(Cadets))

QR(Cadets) are orders and instructions issued to the Canadian Cadet Organizations (CCO) under the authority of the National Defence Act. They apply to QR (Cadets) apply to cadets and cadet corps of the Sea, Army and Air Cadets; cadet instructors; and where the context so requires, other members of the Canadian Armed Forces and civilian instructors.
